## **Part 3 – Periodic Items**

- 3.0 **Canadian Coast Guard Ships Deployment:** Any cadet that meets the following requirements and conditions, who wishes to apply for this specific deployment, please see the Administration Officer ASAP and no later than 16 February 2010.

The requirements and conditions are:

1. Cadet must have attained the age of 16 years as of the first day of January 2010 but not 19 before returning home on completion.
  2. Have successfully completed Phase IV from the Corps program.
  3. Holds the minimum rank of PO2.
  4. Have successfully completed any TG2, TG3 or 6-8 week specialty course.
  5. Be fluent in English or French (depending on the operation language of the CCG Ship(s)), which signifies an excellent understanding of the language and the ability to express one's self in it.
  6. Have successfully completed the Air Cadets' Athletic Instructor's physical fitness test.
  7. Be mature, and considered to be a credit to the Sea Cadet Organization; and be recommended for this training by all levels in the chain of command.
  8. **NO** Waivers will be granted on any of the above requirements and conditions.
- 3.1 **Calgary Branch NLC Fundraiser – Purdy's Easter Chocolates:** All officers, cadets and parents are encouraged to participate in this much needed fundraiser as all the funds are going to our Trip Account. The campaign will run from February 9<sup>th</sup> to March 4<sup>th</sup>. Delivery will be the week of March 24<sup>th</sup>.

- 3.2 **Picture ID:** All cadets must have a picture ID: Drivers Licence, Learners Licence or Alberta Registries ID.
- 3.3 **Security Policy:** As per Cato 23-07 Para 6a. All Civilian Volunteers must wear Navy League ID badges when at Cadet Events, parade nights, exercises. Volunteers will remove their ID badge only while on parade. Parents and any adults or former cadets having business with the Admin or any of the officers must leave as soon as their business is done. Parents and adults or former-cadets are allowed to watch colours and sunset. Please see the CO if you have any questions.
